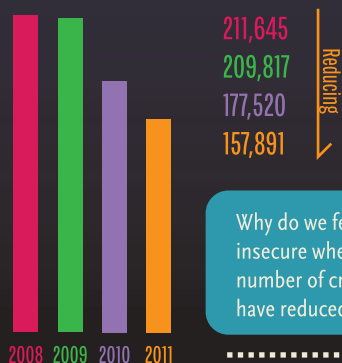

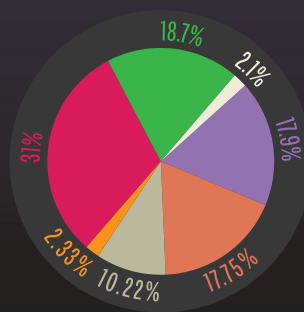

### Types of Crimes Reported (2011)

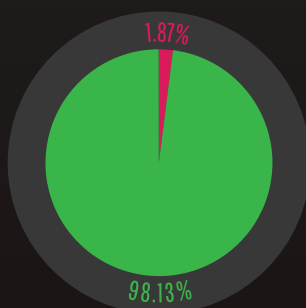


Motorcycle Theft (48,946)

Official statistics comprise only of index crimes. Many other crimes listed in the Penal Code are not included.

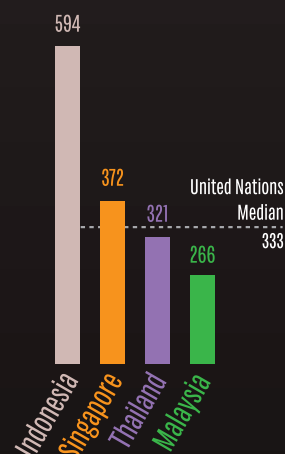
### Crimes Involving Foreigners (2005-2009)

Locals (974,439)

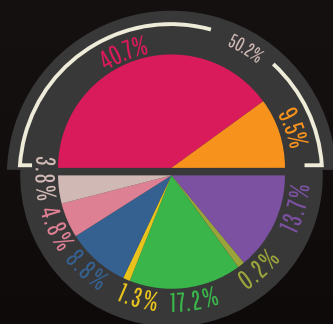
Why are we afraid of foreigners who are here to make an honest living?
